








#### Race/Ethnicity

  - 17 different communities!




- Rent vs. own

  - Other = 3.20%


Total household income








# WHAT DO YOU THINK ARE THE TOP 5 HEALTH CONCERNS IN OUR COMMUNITY?




### WHAT DO YOU THINK ARE THE TOP 5 BARRIERS TO HEALTH AND WELL-BEING IN OUR COMMUNITY?




### THINKING OF YOU AND YOUR FAMILY, WHICH BARRIERS KEEP YOU FROM BEING HEALTHY?






