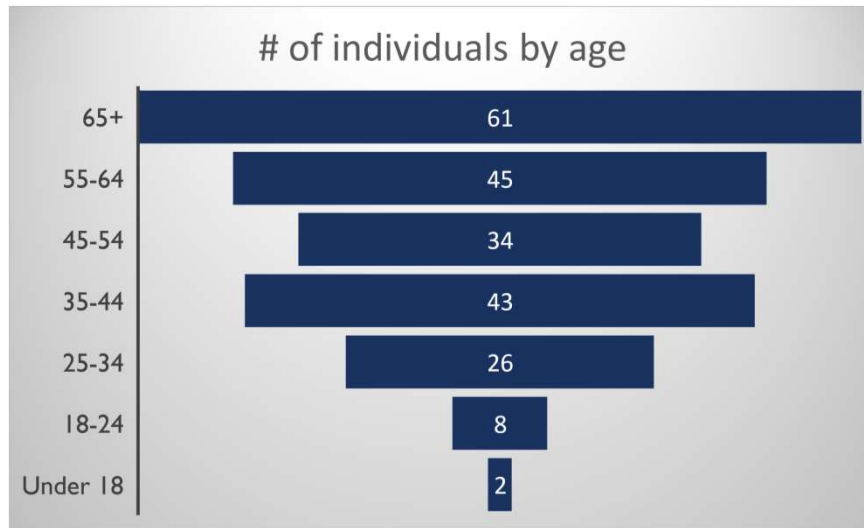

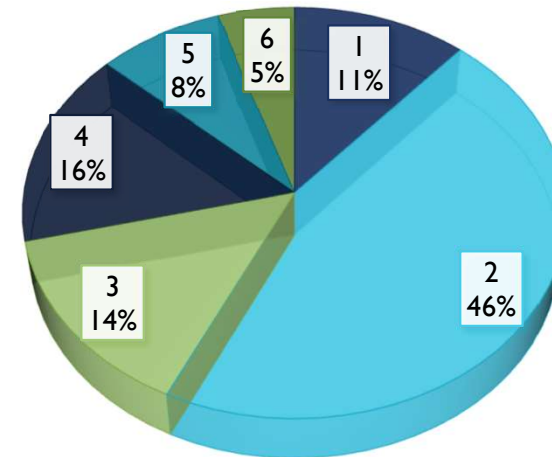


SURVEY SUMMARY

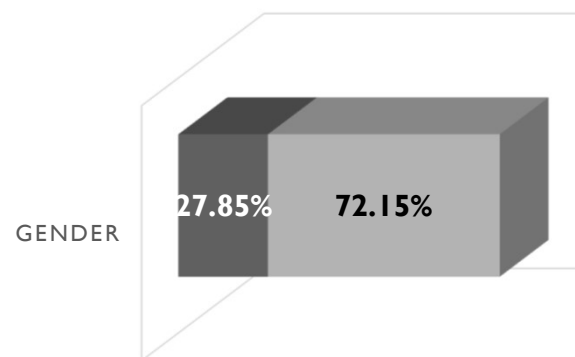


HOUSEHOLD SIZE

■ Male ■ Female

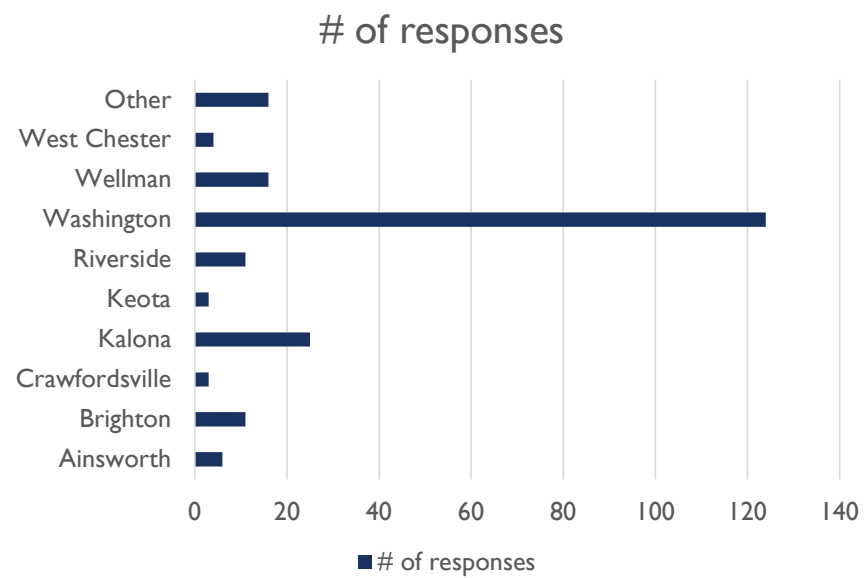


Race/Ethnicity

- 17 different communities!

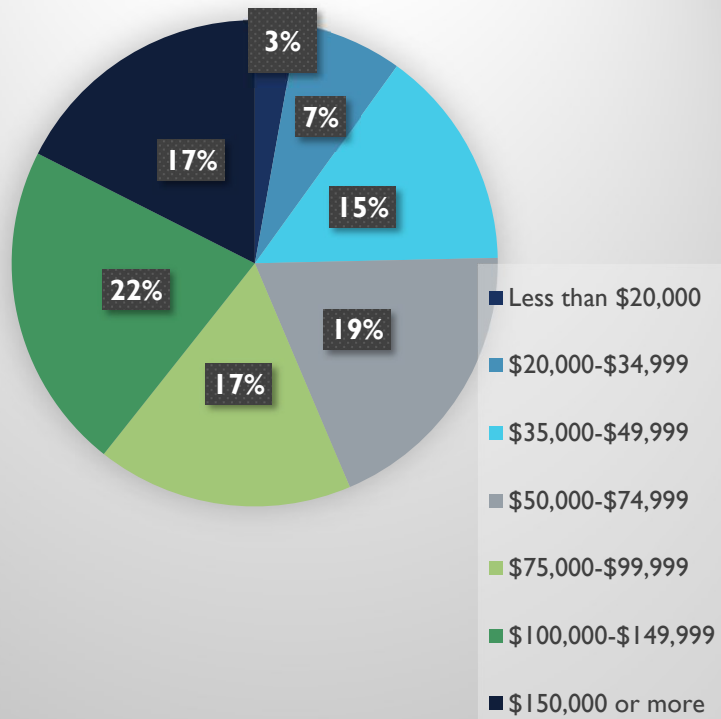


- Rent vs. own

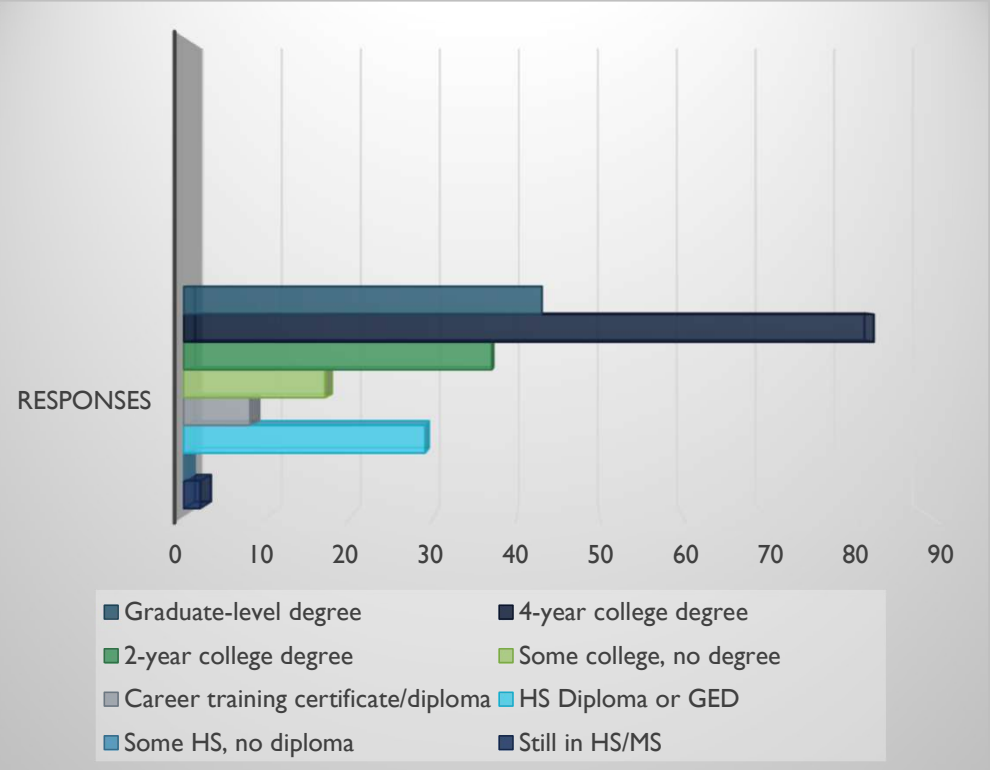
- Rent = 14.16%

- Other = 3.20%



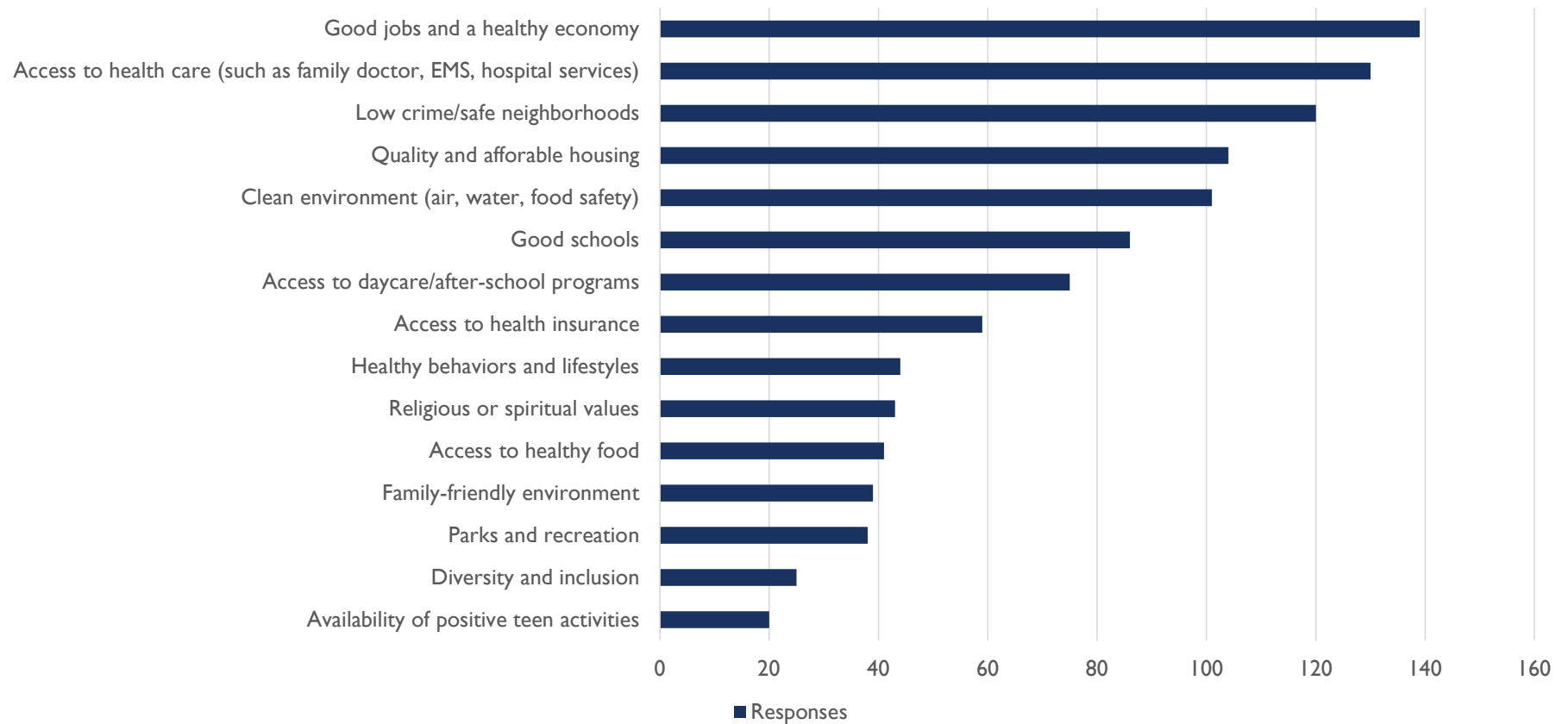

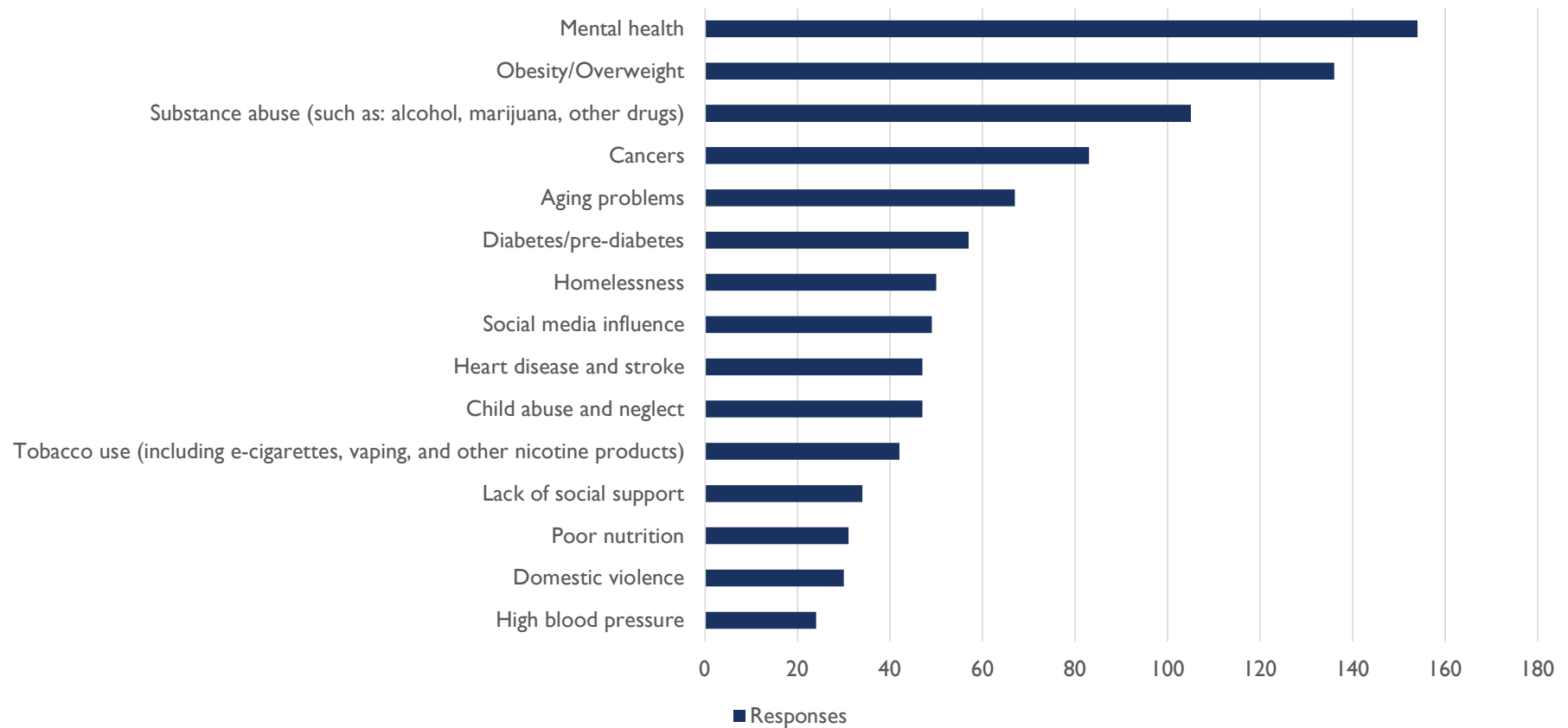

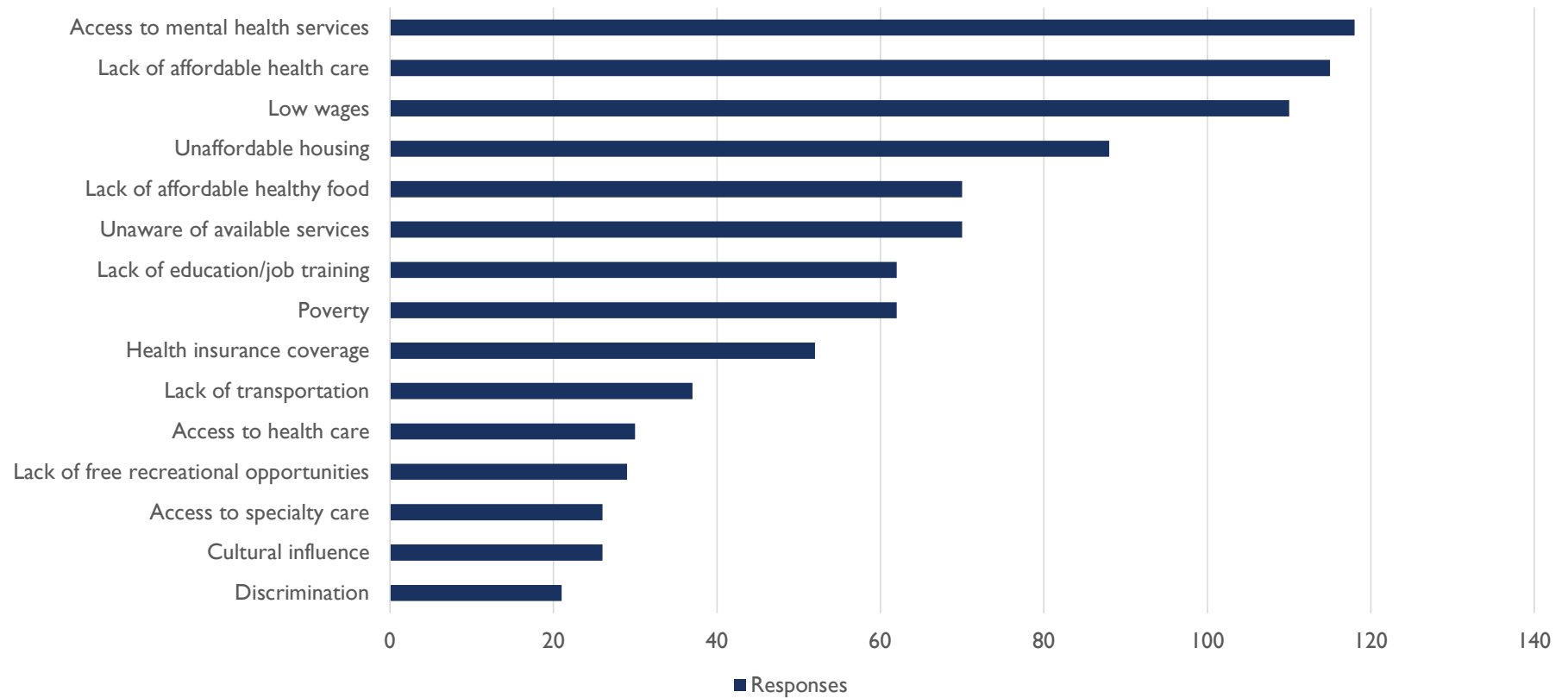

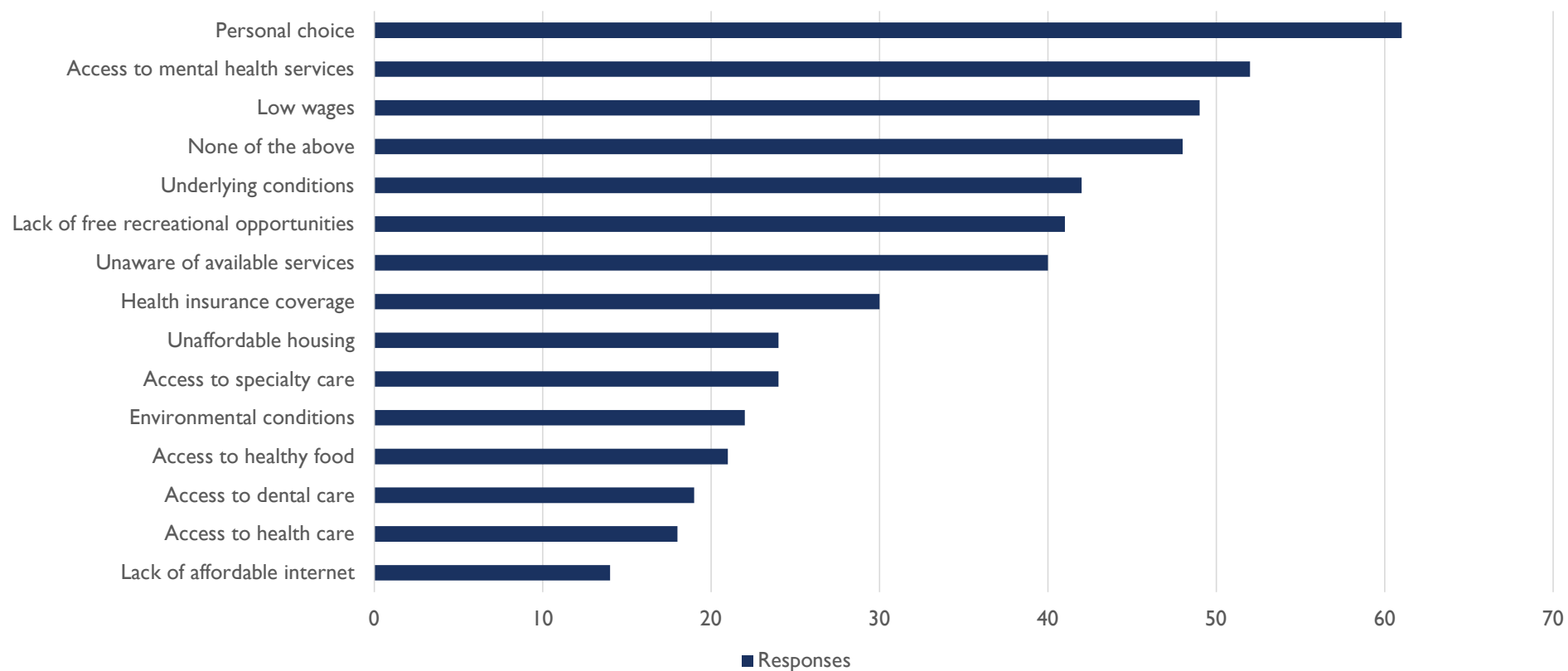
WHAT DO YOU THINK ARE THE TOP 5 HEALTH CONCERNS IN OUR COMMUNITY?



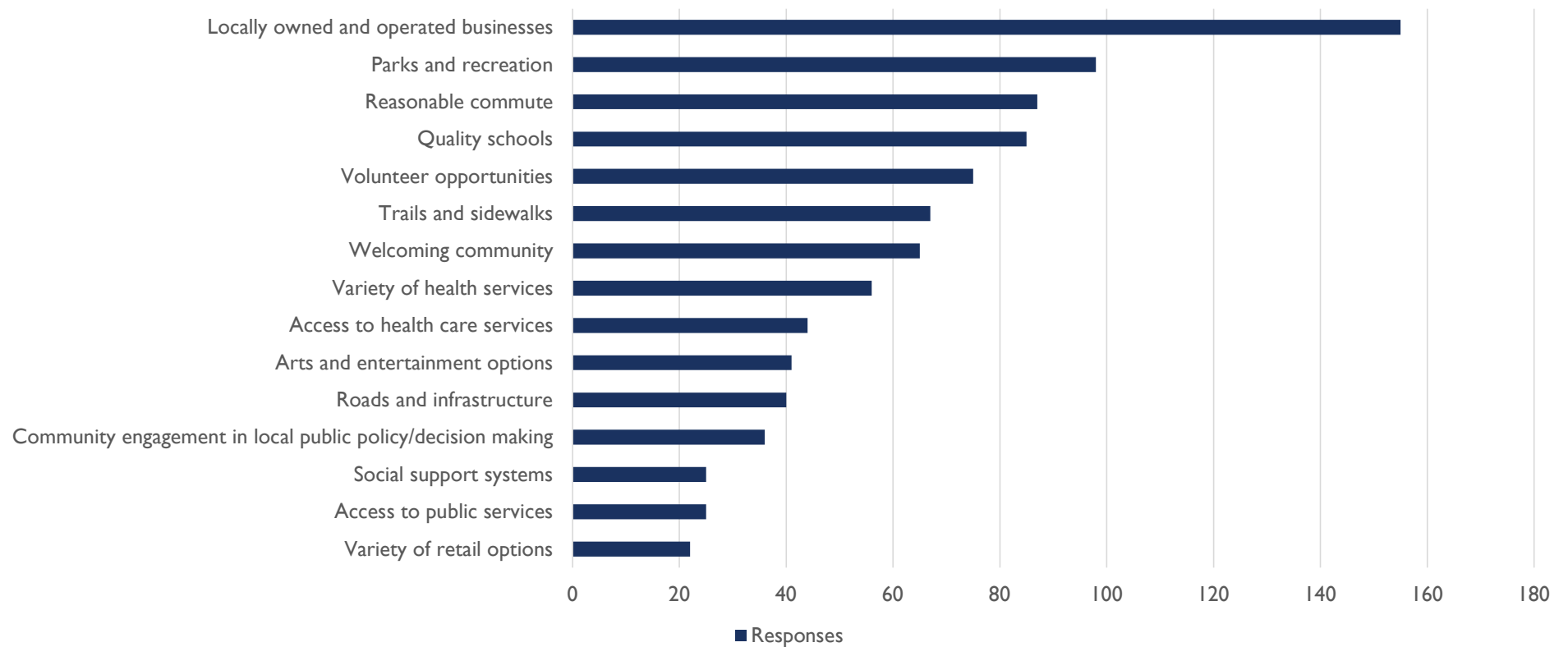
WHAT DO YOU THINK ARE THE TOP 5 BARRIERS TO HEALTH AND WELL-BEING IN OUR COMMUNITY?



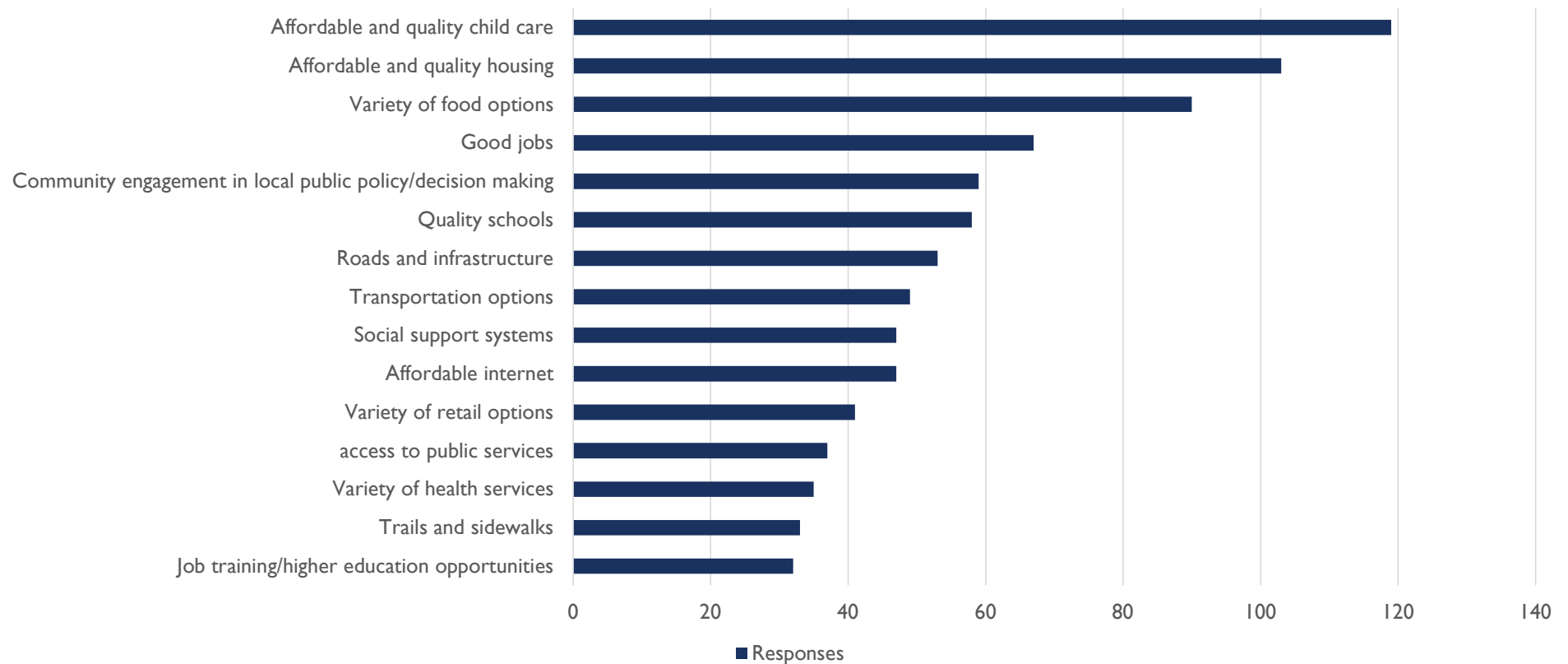
THINKING OF YOU AND YOUR FAMILY, WHICH BARRIERS KEEP YOU FROM BEING HEALTHY?



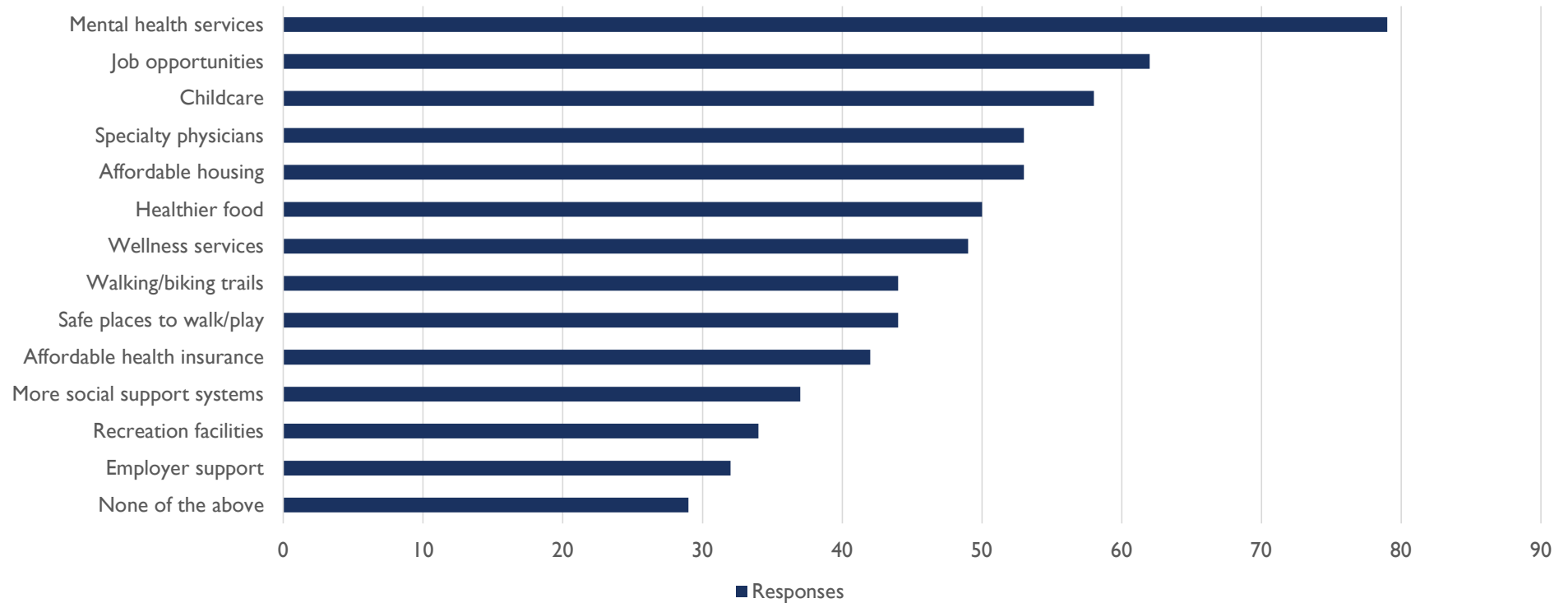

- Often true: 4.11%
- Somewhat true: 12.79%
- Never true: 83.11%



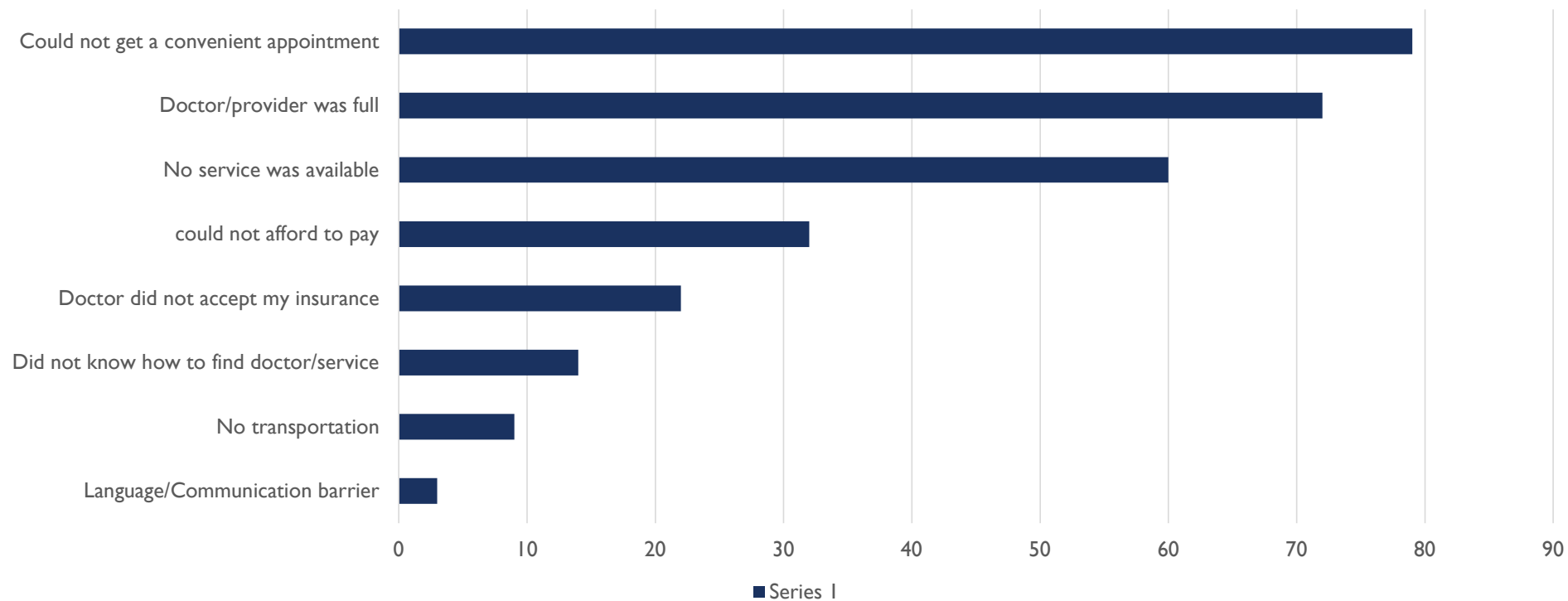
IN THE PAST 12 MONTHS, THE FOOD WE BOUGHT JUST DID NOT

- **Primary care:** 16.44%
- **Dentist:** 15.07%
- **Mental health provider:** 34.25%
- **Specialty doctor:** 28.31%
- **Social services/community assistance:** 14.62%
- **Emergency care:** 6.85%
- **Public health/immunizations:** 2.74%
- **Family or parent support:** 11.87%
- **Child care services:** 21.46%

- Never: 61.19%
- 1-2 times: 31.96%
- 3-5 times: 6.85%

IN THE PAST YEAR, HOW MANY TIMES HAVE YOU USED THE WASHINGTON COUNTY AMBULANCE SERVICE?

- Never: 92.45%
- 1-2 times: 7.08%
- 3 or more times: <1%

 - Newsletters via mail (city water bill inserts)
 - Flyers placed throughout community

HOW WOULD YOU RATE YOUR KNOWLEDGE ON PERSONAL FINANCES?

- Poor: 3.74%
- Fair: 17.29%
- Good: 42.99%
- Very good: 35.98%
