WHEREAS, IIHR Hydrosience and Engineering's water quality monitoring program, which has been collecting water quality data for more than 10 years to aid in the understanding of the health of our waterways, offers access to a wide range of real-time nutrient data crucial to the monitoring and decision; and

WHEREAS, Polk County has a vested interest in sustaining water quality research and historical data for the long term benefit of the community; and

WHEREAS, when widely available, water quality data aids both public and private partners in decision-making related to the health and betterment of our waterways.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED Polk County Board of Supervisors approves the use of \$90,344.03 remaining of the budgeted CISWRA project funds and \$109,655.97 of ARPA water quality funds to be used to fund the IIHR Water Quality Network.
